



"Crowns" in the Bible

Matthew 27:29 "And after twisting together a crown of thorns, they put it on His head, and a reed in His right hand; and they knelt down before Him and mocked Him, saying, 'Hail, King of the Jews!' " NASB

The word crown, crowns or crowned appears 71 times in the Bible. A crown is a circular article worn on the head to indicate authority or supremacy, or it is the act of placing such an article on the head. Ones made of precious metal often with jewels were worn by royalty or other governmental leaders, and ones constructed of vegetation were worn by the winners of sporting events. Sometimes one was just worn as a decoration to flaunt wealth. Sometimes the word was just used to mean the top of something. When it is used in the Bible it sometimes meant a literal crown, but just as often its meaning was metaphorical or perhaps even spiritual.

For further thought:

- [s] Compare Genesis 3:17-19 with John 19:1-5. What did you learn?
- [t] In 2nd Timothy 2:5 the prize was a wreath, a crown of laurel, as a symbol of their achievement. But Paul is not talking about sports except as an analogy for something else. What is he really talking about?
- [u] The Greek word for crown is *stephanas*. The martyr, Stephan, had that word for a name. (Who would name their child "Crowned" and why?) Read his story in Acts chapters 6, 7 and 8. Does his name fit his character? Why?
